VIRTUES OF THE MONTH

Safar-ul-Muzaffar صَفَرُ الْمُظْفَرِ

This month is the month of descent of misfortunes. In a year, one million and eighty thousand misfortunes descend, out of which nine hundred and twenty thousand descend in the month of Safar.

Hadeeth Shareef:

It is therefore mentioned in a Hadeeth by the Beloved of Allaah عز وجل, Hadrat Sayyidina wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafa صلى الله عليه وسلم that anyone who gives me the good news that he survived Safar, I will give him the good news of that person's entering Paradise.

Hadrat Adam's عليه السلام mistake occurred in this month. Hadrat Ibraheem عليه السلام was put into the fire on the 1st of Safar. Hadrat Ayyub عليه السلام got involved in his misfortune in this month. Hadrat Yahya عليه السلام, Hadrat Idrees عليه السلام, Hadrat Yunus عليه السلام and Hadrat Sayyidina wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafa صلى الله عليه وسلم, the Beloved of Allaah عز وجل were all involved in misfortunes in this month. Hadrat Habel (Able, son of Hadrat Adam عليه السلام) was martyred in this month.

It is essential for all Muslims to perform, on the first night of Safar, 4 Rakaa'ah (Nafl Salaah) after Salaatul 'Ishaa in a manner that:

- ◆ in the 1st Rakaa'ah (after Soorah Al-Faatihah), recite Soorah Al-Kaafiroon 15 times
- ◆ in the 2nd Rakaa'ah (after Soorah Al-Faatihah), recite Soorah Al-Ikhlaas 15 times
- ◆ in the 3rd Rakaa'ah (after Soorah Al-Faatihah), recite Soorah Al-Falaq 15 times
- ◆ and in the 4th Rakaa'ah (after Soorah Al-Faatihah), recite Soorah An-Naas 15 times.

After Salaam, recite إِيَّاكَ نَعْبُدُ وَإِيَّاكَ نَسْتَعِينُ (Iyyaaka na'abudu wa Iyyaaka nasta'een) and recite Salaat-un-Nabee صلى الله عليه وسلم (SallAllaahu 'Alaihi wa Sallam) 70 times.

Allaah عز وجل will protect him from all misfortunes and difficulties and bestow great Thawaab (rewards) upon him. (Raahatul Quloob)
