

VIRTUES OF THE MONTH

Sha'baan-ul-Mu'azzam شبان المعطف

Hadeeth Shareef:

Hadrat 'Aaishah Siddeeqah المعنوفة has narrated that when the Beloved of Allaah عنوفة , Hadrat Sayyidina wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafa المعنوفة used to fast in the month of Sha'baan, we used to say now that he will not miss fasting even a day and when he abstained (from fasting), we used to say in this month he will not fast. I have never seen the RasoolAllaah منتوفة fast an entire month apart from Ramadaan and I have also never seen him fast in a month more than he did in the month of Sha'baan. (Bukharee Shareef)

Hadeeth Shareef:

Hadrat 'Aaishah Siddeeqah ' narrates that I submitted: "O RasoolAllaah ' why is it that I see you fasting in the month of Sha'baan?" He responded: "O 'Aaishah ' his is a month in which the list of those who have to die in the rest of the year is written and given to the Angel of Death. I want that when my name is written in this list, I am in the state of fasting."

Hadeeth Shareef:

Hadrat Anas مَنْوَجَلُ narrated: It was asked of the Beloved of Allaah عنُّوجَلُ , Hadrat Sayyidina wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafa مَا مَا اللهُ عَلَيْهُ عَلَيْهُ وَسَلَمُ what is the best fast among days of fasting? He مَا مَا اللهُ عَلَيْهُ وَسَلَمُ said: "Fasting in the month of Sha'baan out of respect for Ramadaan."

Hadeeth Shareef:

Hadrat 'Abdullah عنّوبَكُ has narrated that the Beloved of Allaah عنّوبَكُ , Hadrat Sayyidina wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafa معنوبَكُ has said that the person who fasts on the last Monday of Sha'baan will be granted his Maghfirah (salvation) -- not the last day of Sha'baan because for the person who does not fast perpetually, it is prohibited to fast one or two days before Ramadaan.

Hadeeth Shareef:

Hadrat Anas bin Maalik مَا وَالْمَا has narrated that the Beloved of Allaah عنوبيّل , Hadrat Sayyidina wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafa مَا الله has said: "Sha'baan is named Sha'baan because from this month abundance of good bursts from it for Ramadaan and Ramadaan is named Ramadaan because it burns out sins."

Hadeeth Shareef:

Hadrat Abu Hurairah عنَّوجَك, Hadrat Sayyidina wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafa مَا مَا الله has said: "Sha'baan is my month, Rajab is Allaah's, and Ramadaan is my Ummah's. Sha'baan is the remover of sins, Ramadaan complete purifier." Ramadaan is the month of Sha'baan. People are neglectful of it, although deeds are presented to Rabbul 'Aalameen (Lord of the Universe) in this month. I like that at the time of presentation of my deeds, I am fasting."

Virtues of Lailatul Baraat (Night of Baraat)

"Allaahumma innee A'oozu bi 'Afwika min 'iqaabika wa a'oozu bi ridaaka min sakhatika wa a'oozu bika minka jalla wajhuka. Laa uhsee thanaaan 'alaika'Alaa Nafsik."

Translation: "Our Dearest and Beloved Allaah عنّو جَل , I seek Your protection of Your forgiveness from Your punishment and protection of Your pleasure from Your wrath and I seek protection in Your Majestic Face. I cannot enumerate Your Praises as only You can."

I submitted: "O RasoolAllaah مَا مَا مَا اَلَهُ اَلَهُ اللهُ الله

When 1/4th of the night had passed by, Jibreel مَا تَعْنَالُهُ اللهِ came down and said, "O Muhammad مَا اللهُ اللهُ

- ...an Angel speaking out from the 1st door: "(There is) good news for the person who turns tonight (to worship)."
- Another Angel calls out from the 2nd door (of Paradise): "Happy will become the person who prostrates tonight."
- Another Angel calls out from the 3rd door: "Happy will be the person who does Du'aa (Supplication) tonight."
- Another Angel calls out from the 4th door: "Happy will be those who do Dzikr tonight."
- Another Angel from the 5th door calls out: "Happy will be the person who sheds tears with the fear of Allaah عزّوجَك tonight."
- Another Angel calls out from the 6th door: "Happiness is for all Muslims tonight."
- From the 7th door, an Angel calls out: "Is there anyone with a need, his need will be fulfilled."
- From the 8th door, an Angel calls out: "Is there anyone who would ask for forgiveness and he will be forgiven."

I then asked Jibreel : "How long will these doors (of Paradise) be open?" Jibreel said: "From the beginning of the night to daybreak." Then he said: "O Muhammad متنت , the number of people given freedom from the Fire is equal to the hair on all the sheep of Bani Kalb (the tribe of Kalb)." Hadeeth Shareef:

Hadrat 'Ali Al-Murtada KarramAllaahu Wajh has narrated that the Beloved of Allaah عنّوجَل , Hadrat Sayyidina wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafa مَا الله said: "When the 15th of Sha'baan arrives, do Qiyaamul Lail (spend the night in worship), that is, perform Nawaafil (Salaat) and fast during the day because Allaah عنّوجَل descends upon the skies of the world after the sunset and proclaims: "Is there anyone who desires salvation so that I forgive him, anyone who beseeches for provision I will give it to him, anyone who is a victim of misfortunes I will give him freedom from them?" He عنوجَل continues to proclaim this till the daybreak. (Ibne-Maajah, Mishkaat Shareef, Tarteeb Shareef pg. 791)

Virtues of Salaatul Khair

During the 15th night of Sha'baan, perform 100 Rakaa'ah Salaatul Khair and recite Soorah Al-Ikhlaas 1000 times, that is 10 times Soorah Al-Ikhlaas in each Rakaa'ah. Salf Saaliheen (Pious Reformers of the past) used to assemble together and perform this Salaat in Jamaa'at. Hadrat Hasan Basri معنّوجَل narrates that 30 companions (may Allaah عنّوجَل be pleased with them all) of the Beloved of Allaah بعنّوجَل, Hadrat Sayyidina wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafa معنّوجَل gave me the news that anyone who performs this Salaat, Allaah عنّوجَل looks at him 70 times and every time He عنّوجَل looks, He عنّوجَل fulfills one of his needs, the least of his needs being salvation. (Ghuniyatuttalibeen, Tarteeb Shareef pg. 796)

Hadeeth Shareef:

Whoever performs in the month of Sha'baan, 8 Rakaa'ah Nafl and in each Rakaa'ah recites Soorah Al-Ikhlaas 11 times with one Salaam (at the end of the 4 Rakaa'ah) and makes Du'aa to Allaah نومجَل to pass on the Thawaab (rewards) to the soul of Hadrat Sayyadatun Nisaa Faatima-tuzzahraa نومخَلُقُ says: "I will not step into Paradise till I intercede (for the one who did this Salaat)." (Risaalah Fadailush Shuhoor)
