Virtues of the Month

Rabee'-ul-Awwal ربيعُ الأوَّل

It is mentioned in the Jawahar Ghaibi (Jewels of the Unseen) that in this month, the Companions of Hadrat Sayyidinaa wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafaa ﷺ (with whom Allaah عزوجل is pleased), the Taba'een (those who saw the holy Companions) and the Taba' Taba'een (the ones who saw the Taba'een) used to perform as a gift to the Blessed Soul of the Beloved of Allaah عزوجل, Hadrat Sayyidinaa wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafaa ﷺ 20 Rakaa'ah Nafil daily for the first 12 days.

If one cannot perform this Salaah daily, at least it should be performed on the 2nd and 12th days and the gift passed on to the Soul of the Beloved of Allaah عزوجل, Hadrat Sayyidinaa wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafaa ﷺ because the Beloved of Allaah عزوجل, Hadrat Sayyidinaa wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafaa ﷺ came in the dreams of those who performed this Salaah and gave them the good news of Paradise. Seeing the Beloved of Allaah عزوجل, Hadrat Sayyidinaa wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafaa ﷺ in a dream after he ﷺ passed away and for him ﷺ to give the good news of Paradise in that dream is just as if one saw him ﷺ in real life.

It is mentioned in Kitaabul Awrad that on the night the Hilaal (visible moon) is seen, one should perform 16 Rakaa'ah Nafil (voluntary) Salaah in sections of 2 Rakaa'ahs and intentions (Niyyah) of 2 Rakaa'ah each. In each Rakaa'ah after Soorah Al-Faatihah, recite Soorah Al-Ikhlaas 3 times, and after the completion of the 16 Rakaa'ah, recite the following Salaatul Nabi (Durood) on the Beloved of Allaah عزوجل, one thousand times:

اللَّهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلَى مُحَمَّدٍ النَّبِيِّ الْأُمِّيِّ وَرَحْمَةُ اللَّهِ وَبَرَكَاتُهُ.

The above Durood when continued to be recited daily for the first 12 days (one thousand times each day) after Salaatul 'Ishaa, and then going to sleep in the state of wudoo, the reciter will In-Sha-Allaahu Ta'aalaa see the Beloved of Allaah عزوجل, Hadrat Sayyidinaa wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafaa ﷺ.

It is written in Kitaabul Mashaikh that from the night on which the Hilaal of Rabee'-ul-Awwal is seen, if one recites the following Durood 1,025 times after Salaatul 'Ishaa:

اللَّهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلَى مُحَمَّدٍ وَعَلَى آلِ مُحَمَّدٍ كَمَا صَلَّيْتَ عَلَى إِبْرَاهِيمَ وَعَلَى آلِ إِبْرَاهِيمَ إِنَّكَ حَمِيدٌ مَجِيدٌ

he will see the Beloved of Allaah عَنْ وَجَل, Hadrat Sayyidinaa wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafaa صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ in his dream.

In the same book, it is written that anyone who recites in the month of Rabee'-ul-Awwal one hundred and twenty five thousand times any one of the following two Duroods:

صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ

or

الصَّلَاةُ وَالسَّلَامُ عَلَيْكَ يَا رَسُولَ اللَّهِ

he will certainly see the Beloved of Allaah عَنْ وَجَل, Hadrat Sayyidinaa wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafaa صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ in his dream.
