

# VIRTUES OF THE MONTH

# Muharramul Haraam

# Hadeeth Shareef:

Hadrat Abu Qataadah متنوجَك, Hadrat Sayyidina wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafa متنوجَك said: I hope from Allaah عنوجَك that (in His consideration) the day of 'Aashoorah (10th day of Muharramul Haraam) will atone for the previous (the past year). (Tirmidhi)

# Hadeeth Shareef:

Hadrat Sayyidina wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafa مَا مَا اللهُ الله

NOTE: It must be borne in mind that wherever a promise of forgiveness of sins is made upon the fulfillment of some action, it is only the minor sins that are forgiven. The major sins are not forgiven without true Taubah (repentance).

One should also observe the fast of the 9th of Muharram to safeguard his deed from resemblance with the non-Muslims who fast only on the 10th of Muharram.

# Hadeeth Shareef:

Hadrat Ibne Abbas هَنْ said: When the Beloved of Allaah عَنْوجَك, Hadrat Sayyidina wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafa هَنْ وَجَكُ observed the fast of the day of 'Aashoorah and ordered (his Companions) to fast, they said, "O RasoolAllaah عَنْ وَجَل It is a day revered by the Jews and Christians." The Beloved of Allaah عَنْ وَجَل wills, we will said, "The coming year, if Allaah عَنْ وَجَل wills, we will fast on the ninth (also)." (Muslim, vol. 1, pg. 359)

These Ahadeeth indicate clearly that one should fast on the 9th and 10th of Muharram. However, if one does not manage to fast on the 9th, then he should fast on the 11th of Muharram instead.

#### Hadeeth Shareef:

The Beloved of Allaah عنَّ وَجَلَّ , Hadrat Sayyidina wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafa منَّ وَجَلَّ said: "Observe the fast of 'Aashoorah and oppose the Jews. Fast a day before it or a day after." (Baihaqi). Hence, it is important to either fast on the 9th and 10th of Muharram or the 10th and 11th. To fast only on the day of 'Aashoorah is makrooh tanzeehi as stated by Hadrat Allamah Ibne Aabideen Shaami

Hadrat Abu Hurairah مَنْ وَجَل reports that the Beloved of Allaah عَنْ وَجَل Hadrat Sayyidina wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafa مَنْ وَجَل said: "One who generously spends on his family on the day of 'Aashoorah, Allaah عنّ وجَل will increase (his provision) for the whole year." (Baihaqi, At Targheeb Wat Tarheeb, vol. 2, pg. 116)

#### Hadeeth Shareef:

Hadrat Ibn 'Abbaas المعنوضة has narrated that the Beloved of Allaah عنوفب , Hadrat Sayyidina wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafa منوفب said: The person who fasts on 'Aashoorah (10th day) of Muharram will be given Thawaab (rewards) of 10,000 angels and Thawaab of 10,000 people who perform Hajj and 'Umrah. Anyone who strokes affectionately an orphan's head, Allaah هناو will increase his station in Paradise by the number of hair on the orphan's head and anyone who feeds a fasting True Believer at Iftaar (breaking the fast), it would be considered as if he fed at Iftaar all the Ummah of the Beloved of Allaah منوف , Hadrat Sayyidina wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafa منافع المعادم , till their stomachs are full.

# **Hadeeth Shareef:**

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Hadrat Ibn Abbaas المعتروبية has narrated that the Beloved of Allaah المعتروبية, Hadrat Sayyidina wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafa متروبية said: The person who fasts on the day of 'Aashoorah in Muharram, Allaah will write for him worship of 60 years and in this worship is included fasts during days and nights in worship. Anyone who performs a Ghasl (head shower) on the day of 'Aashoorah, he will not be afflicted with any sickness except the sickness which leads to his preordained death, and anyone who applies Soormah (Collyrium) to his eyes, his eyes will not suffer any pain during the entire year, and anyone who visits a sick person on the day of 'Aashoorah, it would be as if he visited all the progeny of Hadrat Aadam المعتروبية. Anyone who offers a drink of water once on the day of 'Aashoorah, it would be considered that he did not disobey his Lord for even one batting of an eyelash. Anyone who performs on the day of 'Aashoorah 4 Rakaa'ah of Salaat with 2 Salaams and recites after Soorah Al-Faatihah, Soorah Al-Ikhlaas 50 times, Allaah عتروبة will forgive his sins of the past 50 years as well as his sins of the next 50 years and Allaah will reward him with 1,000 palaces in a group above the Noor (Light).

# Hadeeth Shareef:

Hadrat Abu Hurairah هن has narrated that the Beloved of Allaah عن وجَل , Hadrat Sayyidina wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafa من من said: Perform 4 Rakaa'ah with 2 Salaams and in each Rakaa'ah recite Soorah Al-Faatihah once, Soorah Al-Zilzaal once, Soorah Al-Kaafiroon once, and Soorah Al-Ikhlaas once, and after the

completion of the Salaah, recite Salaatun Nabee (Durood) upon the Beloved of Allaah عنَّ وَجَل Hadrat Sayyidina wa Maulaanaa Muhammad Mustafa مَنْ عَلَيْهُ عَلَيْهُ وَمَالِكُ 70 times. (Ghuniyatuttalibeen - Tarteeb Shareef, pgs. 756-758)

# **Hadeeth Shareef:**

Hadrat Shiblee wised to perform 4 Rakaa'ah Nafl daily from the 1<sup>st</sup> till the 10<sup>th</sup> of Muharram and used to recite in every Rakaa'ah, Soorah Al-Faatihah once and Soorah Al-Ikhlaas 15 times and after the Salaam, he presented the Thawaab of this worship to the soul of Hadrat Sayyidina Imaam Husain in his dream in which he turned his face away from Hadrat Shiblee with humbly asked Hadrat Sayyidina Imaam Husain if "Your Honor, where did I go wrong?" The response was: "No wrong has been done. My eyes are ashamed (indebted) at your obligation. Till such time as I can return your favor (which will be) on the Day of Judgment, I am unable to let my eyes meet yours." The honorable grandson of Sayyad-ul-Kaunain (leader of both the worlds in the Shafaa'at (Intercession) on the Day of Judgment of all those who perform this Salaah. (Jawaahar Ghaibee)

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
